Preamble

SUMMER UNIFORM Usually worn in Term 1 & 4

GIRLS

School Dress
or grey shorts & white QoP polo
Girls may choose to wear the summer dress or the grey shorts and polo shirt
White ankle socks
(not low ankle socks – no stockings or leggings)

and / or Maroon Jacket with QoP logo
Compulsory 1st September until 30th April

BOYS

Grey gabardine School Shorts
(elastic waist) PSW brand

Grey school socks

White Polo Shirt with QoP logo PSW brand

Black leather school shoes or
black leather school boots
School Jumper with QoP logo
and / or Maroon Jacket with QoP logo
Compulsory 1st September until 30th April
School hat with QoP logo bucket or legionnaire
Sunglasses

WINTER UNIFORM Usually worn in Term 2 & 3

GIRLS

School winter tunic or grey school trousers
Girls may choose to wear the winter tunic or the grey school trousers
Black tights or white socks *(not low ankle socks or leggings)*

White polo, long or short sleeve with QoP logo

School jumper with QoP logo
and / or Maroon Jacket with QoP logo

Black leather school shoes or black leather
school boots

Compulsory 1st September until 30th April
School hat with QoP logo bucket or legionnaire
Sunglasses

BOYS

Grey school trousers or shorts *(PSW brand)*

Grey school socks *(not low ankle socks)*

White polo, long or short sleeve with QoP logo

School jumper with QoP logo
and / or Maroon Jacket with QoP logo

Black leather school shoes or black leather
school boots

Compulsory 1st September until 30th April
School hat with QoP logo bucket or legionnaire
Sunglasses

SPORTS UNIFORM All students

Black short with white QoP logo

Black School Track Pants with QoP logo

Maroon jacket with QoP logo

House colour short sleeved polo shirt with QoP logo

White sports socks *(not low ankle socks)*

Runners

Compulsory 1st September until 30th April

School hat with QoP logo (bucket or legionnaire)

Sunglasses

OTHER ITEMS: All students

Hair:

Student's hair should be neat and tidy.

No extreme hair cuts or colours are acceptable.

Long hair should be tied back at all times.

Hair restraints (baubles, scrunchies etc) should be in school colours.

Jewellery:

Students may wear a watch only.

Earrings:

Students may wear only sleepers or studs in their ears

Raincoats:

Raincoats in an acceptable school colour are available from the Uniform Shop

School Bags:

Students are required to use the official school bag only.

No Hat, No Sunglasses, No Play Policy

The school has a No Hat, No Sunglasses, No Play Policy in force 1st September until 30th April.

All children and staff members, when outside during this period must wear a hat and sunglasses.

Uniform Shop

Queen of Peace operates its own Uniform Shop on site.

The Uniform Shop is open each Friday afternoon. 2:30pm – 3:30pm

The Uniform Shop is located at the school in the Visual Art Space.

Children who are out of correct school uniform require a note from parents explaining why they are out of uniform. Notes should be renewed weekly and handed to their classroom teacher.
