

### **Quick Start Guide - Remote Learning**

### Years Prep -6

- The Learning experiences are shared on a "Must do/Could do" process.
- "Must do" tasks are the learning experiences that your child must do. When your child has finished the "Must do" activities he/she can move on to the "Could do" tasks.
- Specialist teachers will use **Seesaw**

## Years Prep - 3

- Teachers will send out your 'Must Do' learning experiences in the morning, by 8:30 every day. 'Could Do' activities may be posted weekly for children in Years P-3.
- Children in Years Prep 3 will use Seesaw
- Teachers will help children with how to get onto Seesaw
- Teachers will be available to help children's learning, and communicate with parents between the following times on the days they work.

9:00am - 11.00am, 1:00 pm - 3.00pm

- You can communicate with teachers using the Seesaw messaging service.
- Teachers may also ring or email families.

#### **Years 4 - 6**

- Teachers will send out your 'Must Do' learning experiences in the morning by 8:30 every day or on Monday for the week.
- Children in **Years 4 6 will use Google Classrooms** and will still use Seesaw to share some work with families.
- Teachers will be available to help children's learning, and communicate with parents between the following times on the days they work.

9:00am - 11.00am, 1:00 pm - 3.00pm

- You can communicate with teachers using the Seesaw messaging service.
- Teachers may also ring or email families.
